How We Did

On Tuesday, May 5, 2026, our Grade 6 committee ran the concession at the Surrey Catholic Schools Track Meet, hosted by St. Matthew's at Holy Cross Regional High School. It was our largest event yet -- families from across the district came through all day, and our hot food sold out completely (all 192 burgers and 192 hot dogs). We raised approximately \$4,290 in net proceeds for the Class of 2027.

This was our third concession event. We raised \$1,332 at Guardians of the Net in November and \$3,604 at Guardians of the Court in February. The steady climb comes from a sharper menu, earlier pre-orders, high-margin items, and the generous participation of our Grade 6 families.

A big part of this result came from Grade 6 families who donated goods or funded inventory through e-transfer pledges. These contributions were sold at concession prices at little or no cost to the committee -- and nearly everything sold out. With thanks to:
